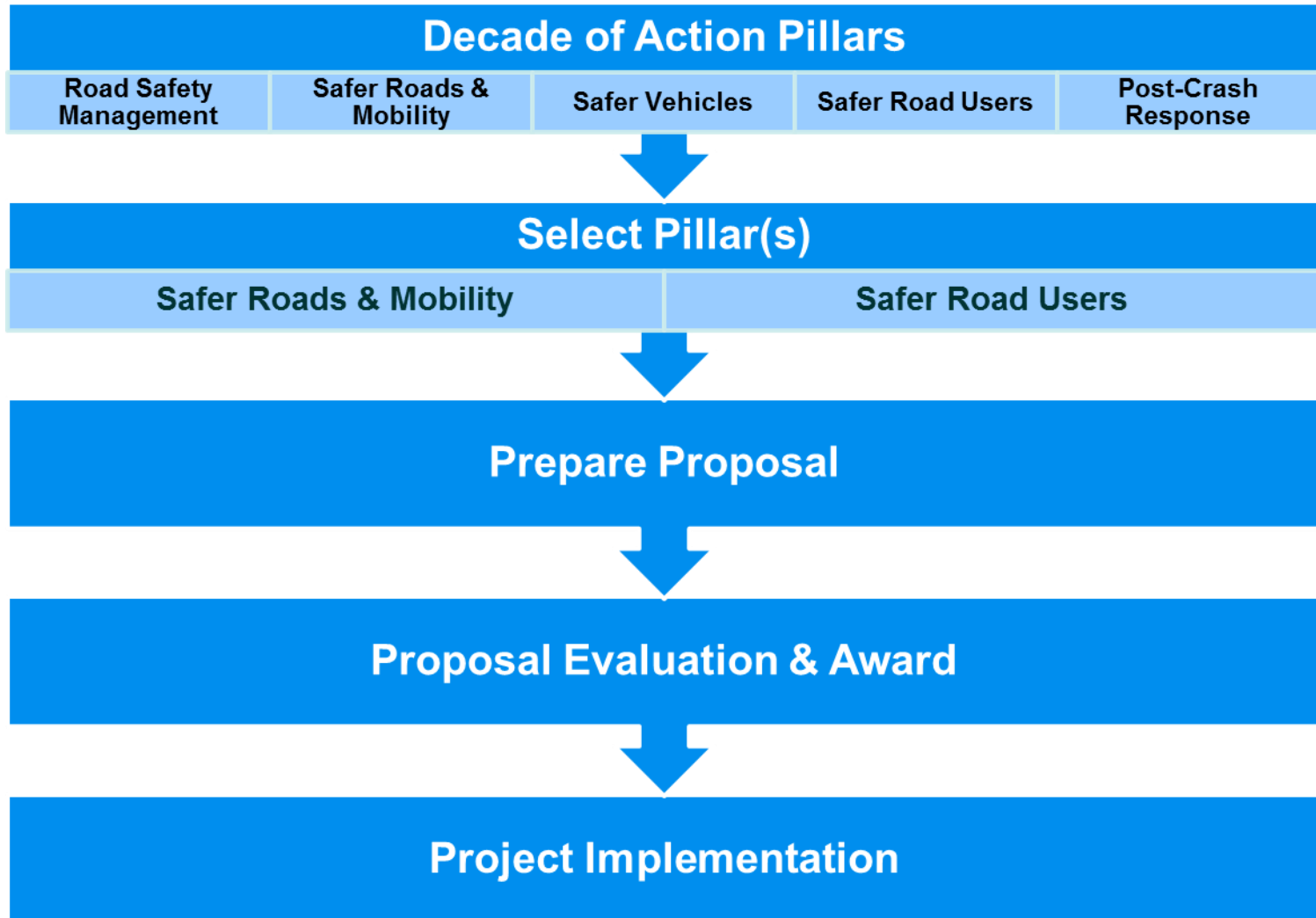

Eligible Activities

Safer Roads

- Promote safe operation, maintenance and improvement of existing road infrastructure
- Promote the development of safe new infrastructure that meets the mobility and access needs of all users

Safer Road Users

- Increase awareness of road safety risk factors and prevention measures and implement social marketing campaigns to help influence attitudes and opinions on the need for road traffic safety programmes.

* realistic=10, max=15 for matching CDB contribution with cash or in-kind resources from Stakeholders, 30 for exceeding. Evidence of Stakeholder commitment submitted with proposal.



Challenge Schedule

- Proposal Due Date – July 1, 2013
- Evaluation
- Award – July 15, 2013
- Implementation – August 1, 2013 to May 1, 2014
- Report on Results – May 24, 2014



Implementation

- Winners manage all aspects of implementation
- GOSL to provide overall guidance and supervision
- CDB to provide mentoring and support
- GOSL forwards payment requests based on outputs to CDB for processing
- Direct payment by CDB to contractors /suppliers/consultants



Post Implementation

- Project Completion Report detailing project activities and results
- Present results at CDB's 2014 Youth Forum in Guyana
- Present results at CDB's BOG Meeting in Guyana



Way Forward

- Form into Project Teams
- Maximum size – 5 persons
- Indicate interest in participating by May 31, 2013
- Identify proposed activity to confirm eligibility by June 14, 2013
