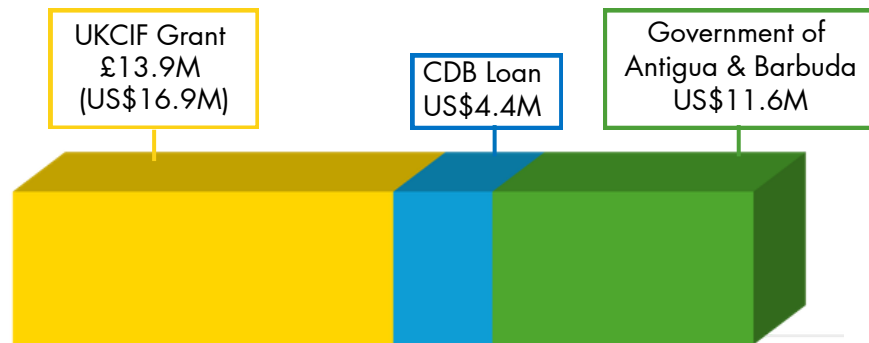
PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Used by 75% of the Population
- Construction Completion - March 2027

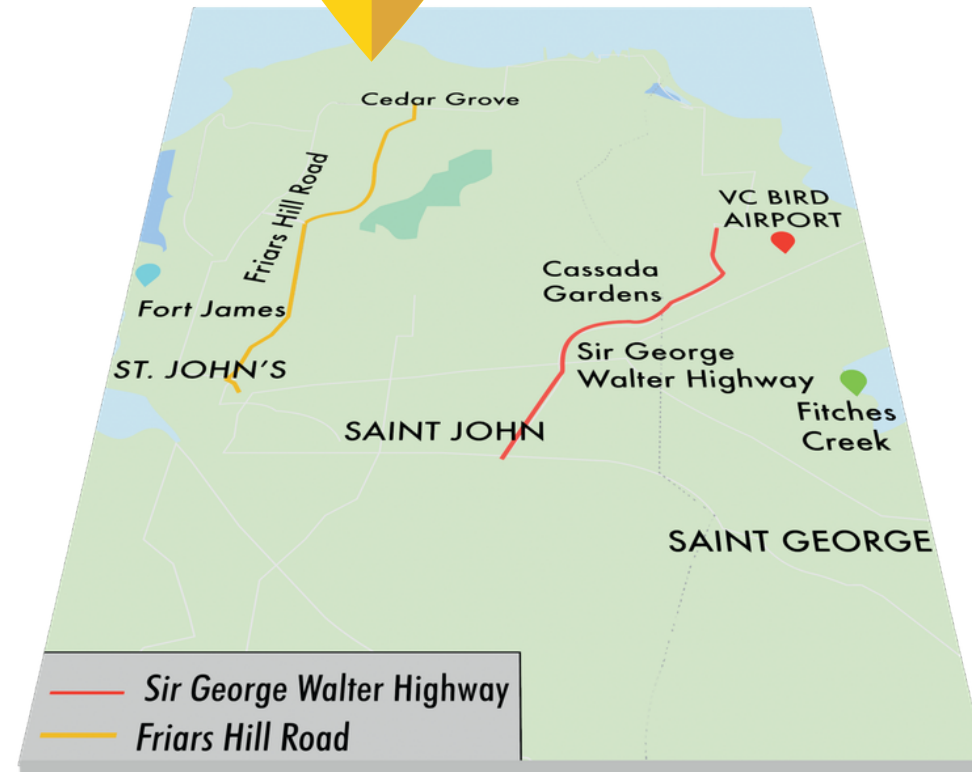
