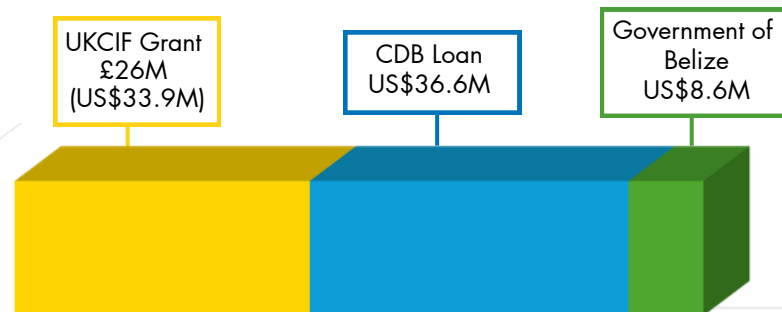
PROJECT OVERVIEW

- 59 km Road Upgrade
- Construction of 6 Bridges
- Corridor: The Coastal Highway, a Critical Junction Connecting the George Price and Hummingbird Highways
- Communities Reached: 49,000 Beneficiaries of Reduction in Travel Time, Enhancing Connectivity between the Northern and Southern Districts and 2,000 Residents with Improved Access in the communities of Gales Point, Hope Creek, La Democracia, and Mullins River
- Construction Completion - July 2023

- Reduced Travel Times: From Days to Hours After Storms
- Building Local Skills and Resilience
