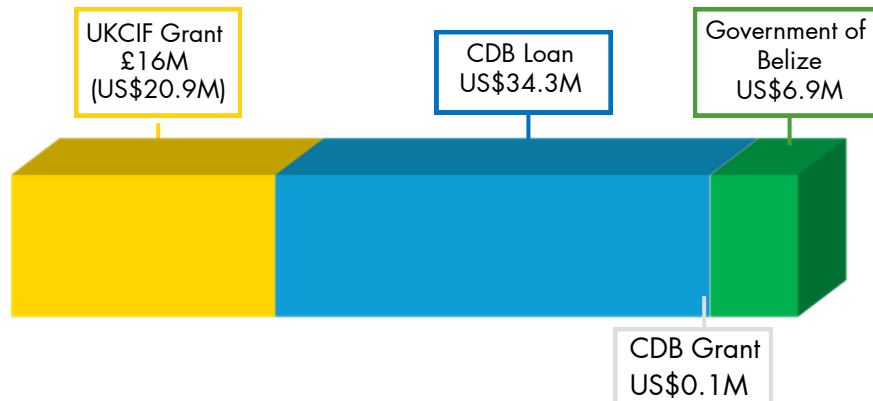
PROJECT OVERVIEW
