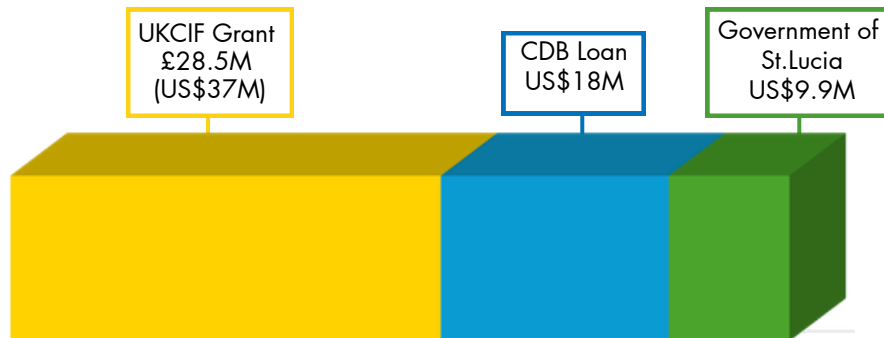
PROJECT OVERVIEW

- 14,000 People to Benefit along the Road Route through Enhanced Mobility and Access
- Construction Completion - September 2026
