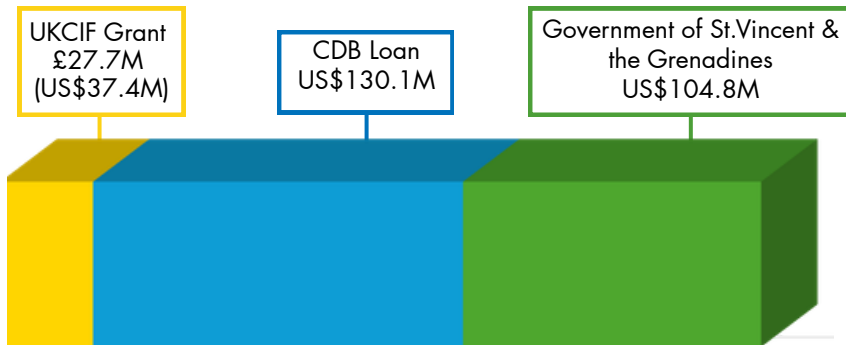
PROJECT OVERVIEW
