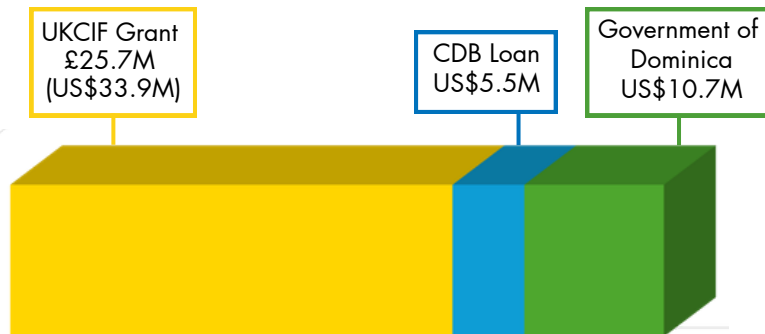

- Construction Completion - December 2026

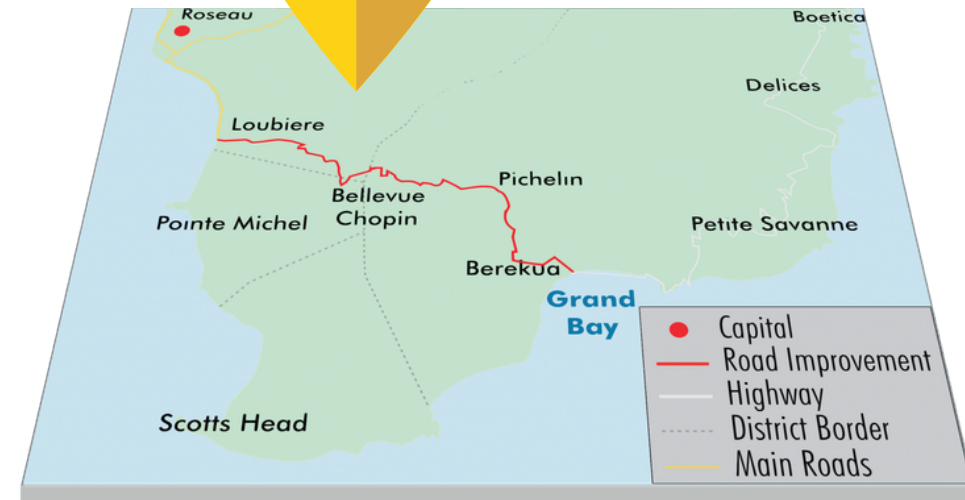
