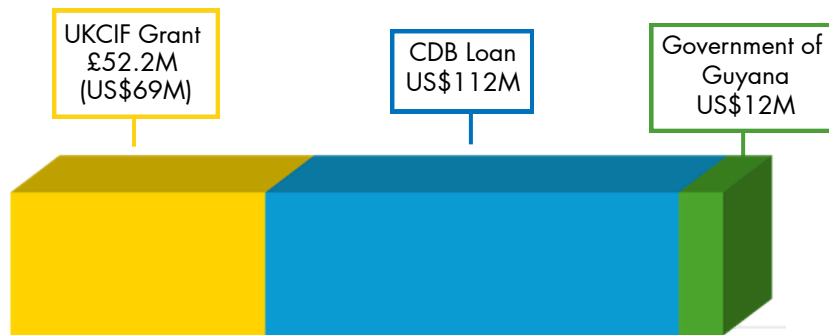
PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Construction Completion - August 2026
