In 2021, the **Basic Needs Trust Fund (BNTF)** approved **5 sub-projects** at a value of

Partnered to provide USD50 million for the CDB-IDB COVID-19 Response Programme

CARIBBEAN EXPORT DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

Partnered to launch a technical assistance grant programme for export-ready MSMEs that were affected by COVID-19. **USD887,380** provided by **CDB** under this programme.



Partnered to provide **EUR 30 million (USD36 million)** to **CDB's Borrowing Member Countries (BMCs)** to purchase **COVID-19 vaccines** and make new healthcare investments.
